क्षमा बलमशक्तानां भाक्तानां भूषणं क्षमा।
क्षमा वशीकृते लोके क्षमया किं न सिद्ध्यति॥

क्षमा निर्बलों का बल है, क्षमा बलवानों का आभूषण है, क्षमा ने इस विश्व को वश में किया हुआ है, क्षमा से कौन सा कार्य सिद्ध नहीं हो सकता वें
न हि कटिश्चत् विजानाति किं कस्य श्वो भविष्यति।

अतः भवः करणीयानि कुर्यादद्यैव बुद्धिमान्॥

कल क्या होगा यह कोई नहीं जानता है इसलिए कल के करने योग्य कार्य को आज कर लेने वाला ही बुद्धिमान है॥

चिता चिंता समाप्रोक्ता बिंदुमात्रं विप्रीशता।
सजीवं दहते चिंता निर्जीवं दहते चिता॥

चिता और चिंता समान कही गयी हैं पर उसमें भी चिंता में एक बिंदु की विशेषता है; चिता तो मरे हुए को ही जलाती है पर चिंता जीवित व्यक्ति को।

क्षणशः कणश्चैव विद्यामर्थं च साधयेत्।
क्षणत्यागे कुतो विद्या कणत्यागे कुतो धनम्॥

क्षण-क्षण विद्या के लिए और कण- कण धन के लिए प्रयत्न करना चाहिए। समय नष्ट करने पर विद्या और साधनों क नष्ट करने पर धन कैसे प्राप्त हो सकता है।।

अपि स्वर्णमयी लंका न मे लक्ष्मण रोचते ।

हे लक्ष्मण! सोने की लंका भी मुझे अच्छी नहीं लगती है। माता और मातृभूमि स्वर्ग से भी बढ़ कर हैं।।

उत्साह श्रेष्ठ पुरुषों का बल है, उत्साह से बढ़कर और कोई बल नहीं है। उत्साहित व्यक्ति के लिए इस लोक में कुछ भी दुर्लभ नहीं है।
